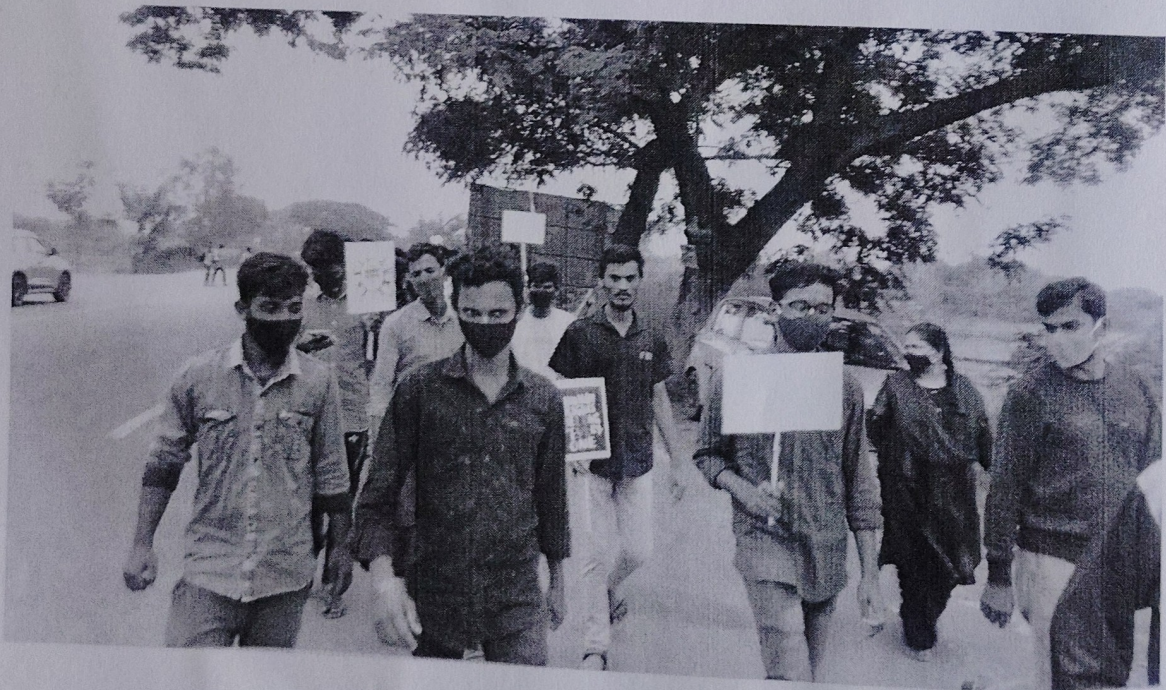
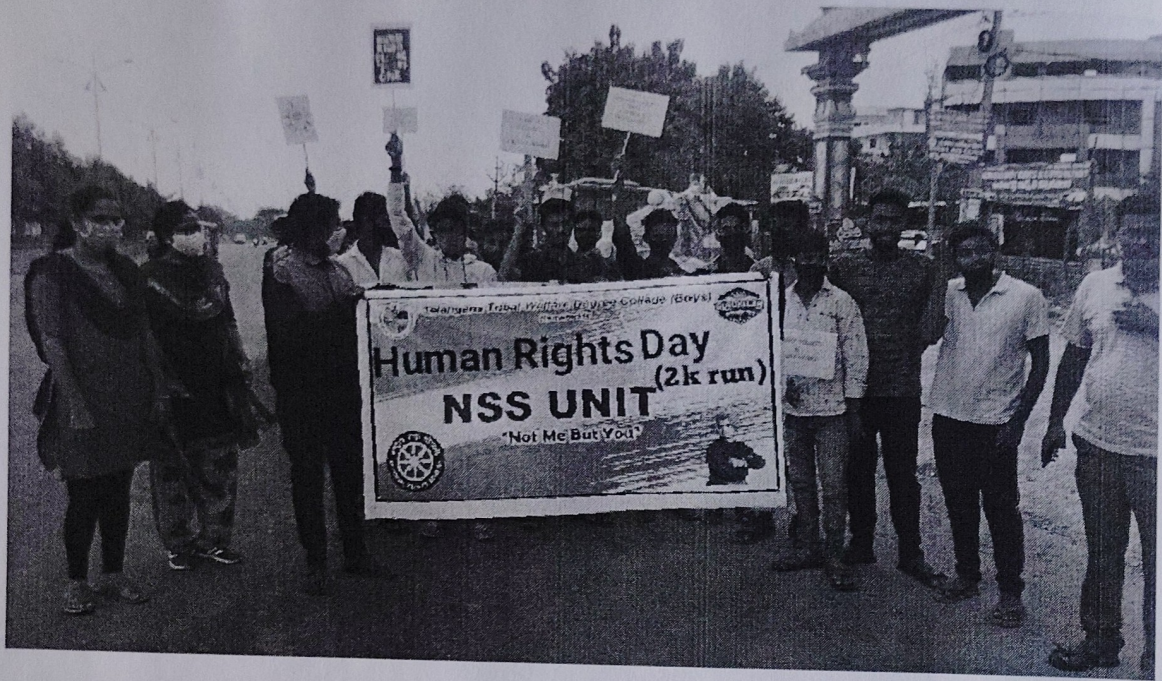


The 2K run turned out successful as onlookers enquired about what programme was.

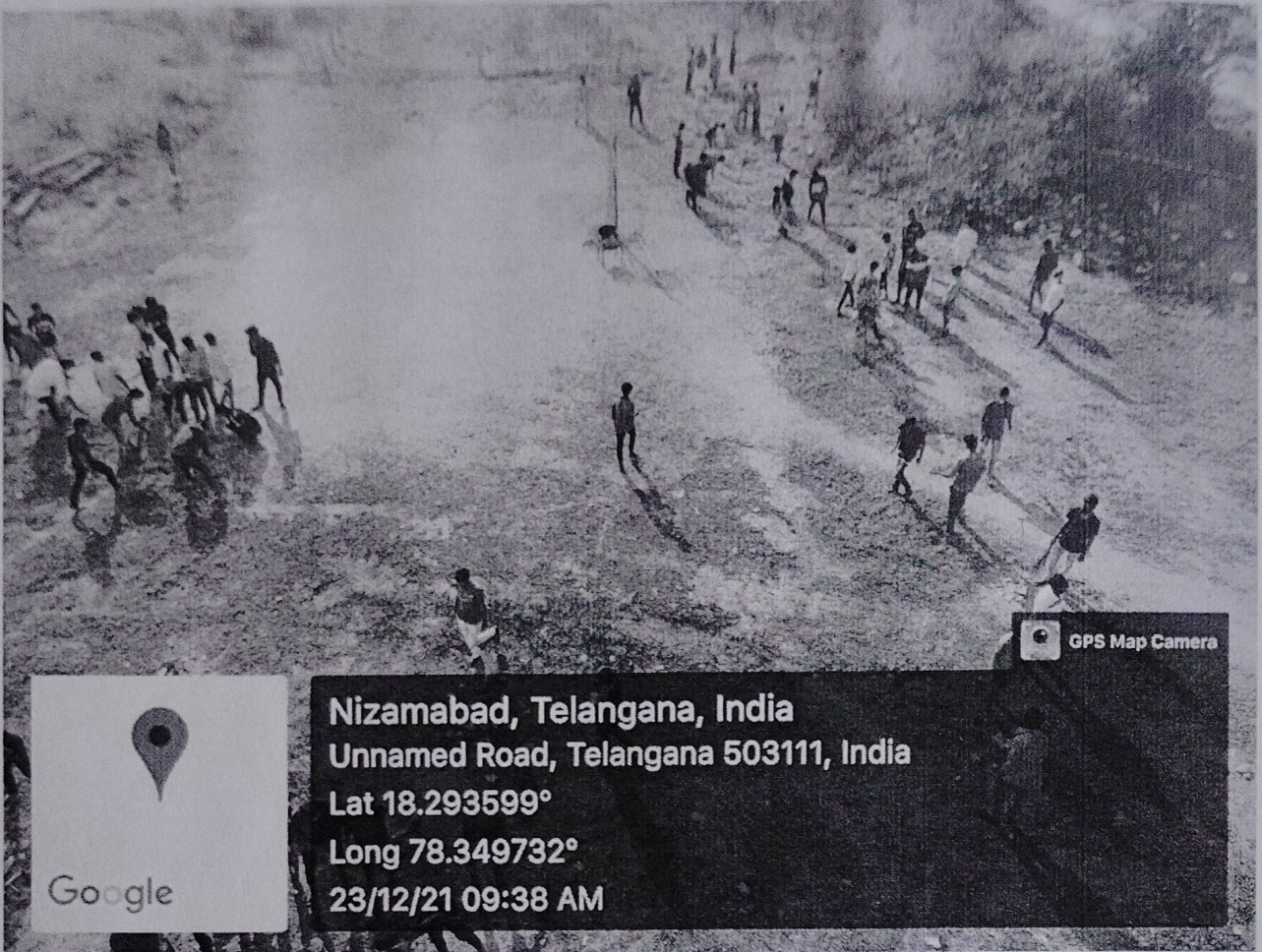
"One Step towards Cleanliness"

Swachh Bharat Mission was started in the year 2014 on the birth anniversary of Mahatma Gandhi on October 2nd.

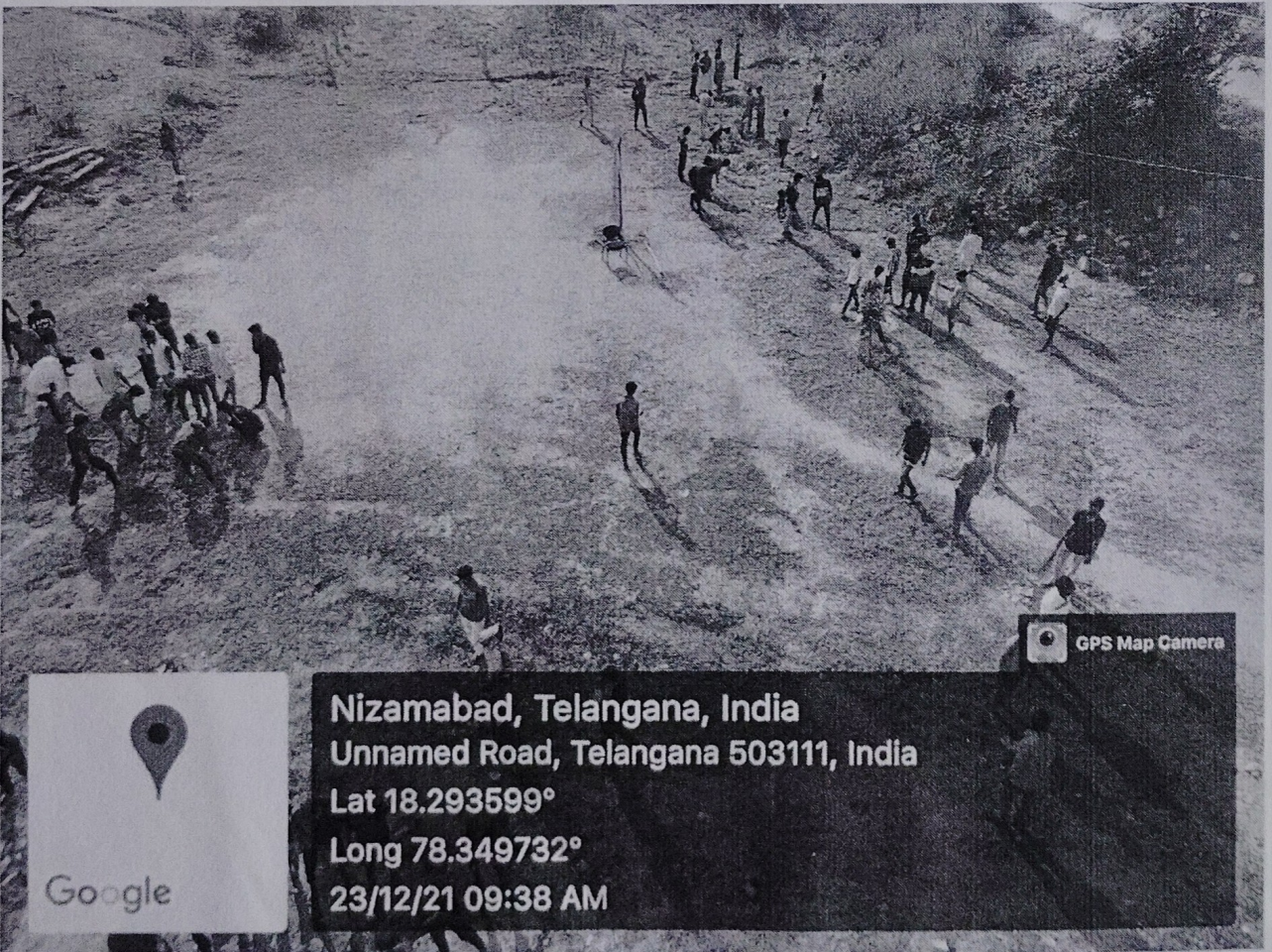
The main aim of the programme is to solve the problems of sanitation and waste management in India by ensuring hygiene across the country.

Our College and our NSS team ensured to share its role in this massive programme. Therefore, our NSS team organised a cleaning programme within the college premises.

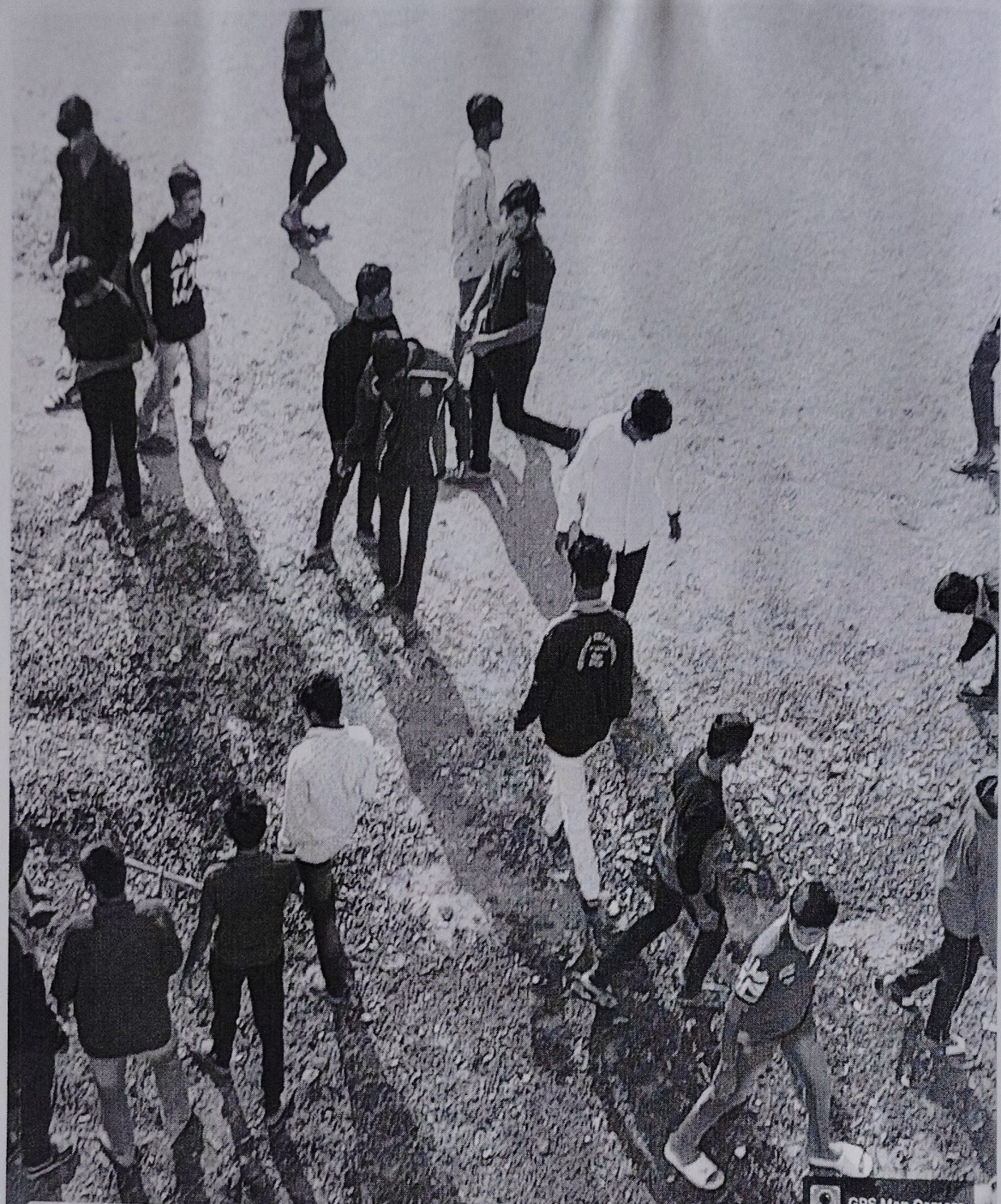
Our students actively participated for a long time and cleaned the entire premises. The programme was successful.

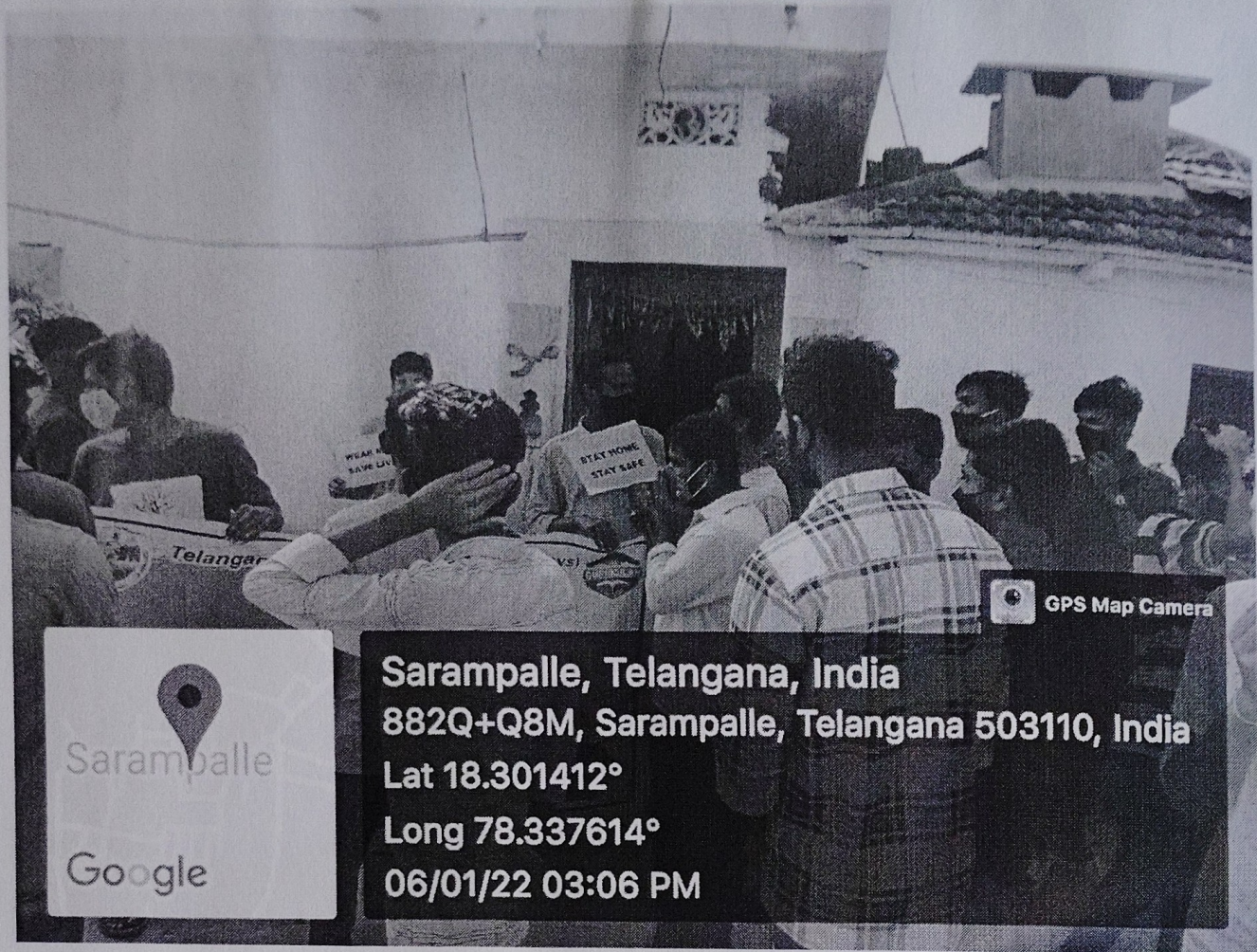
Ever since the outbreak of Covid-19, use of mask became mandatory. However, people in rural areas continue to neglect the usage of mask.

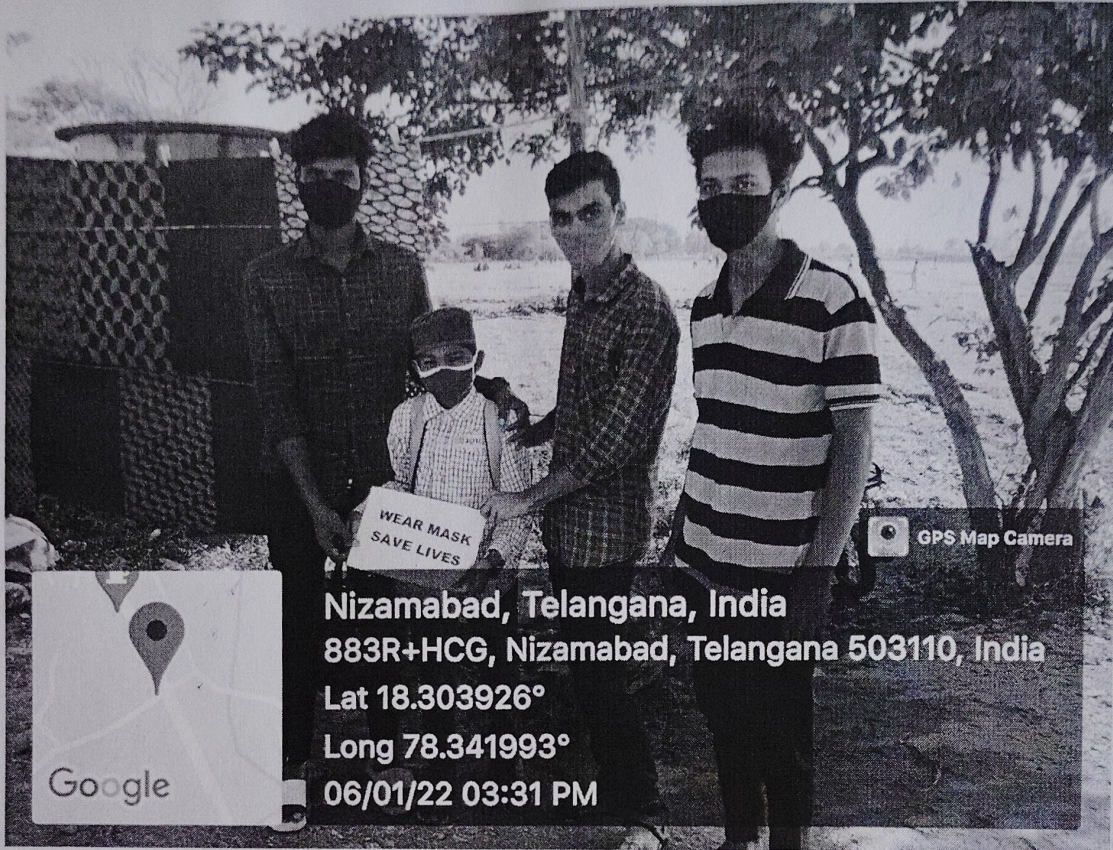

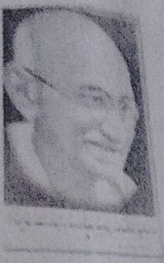

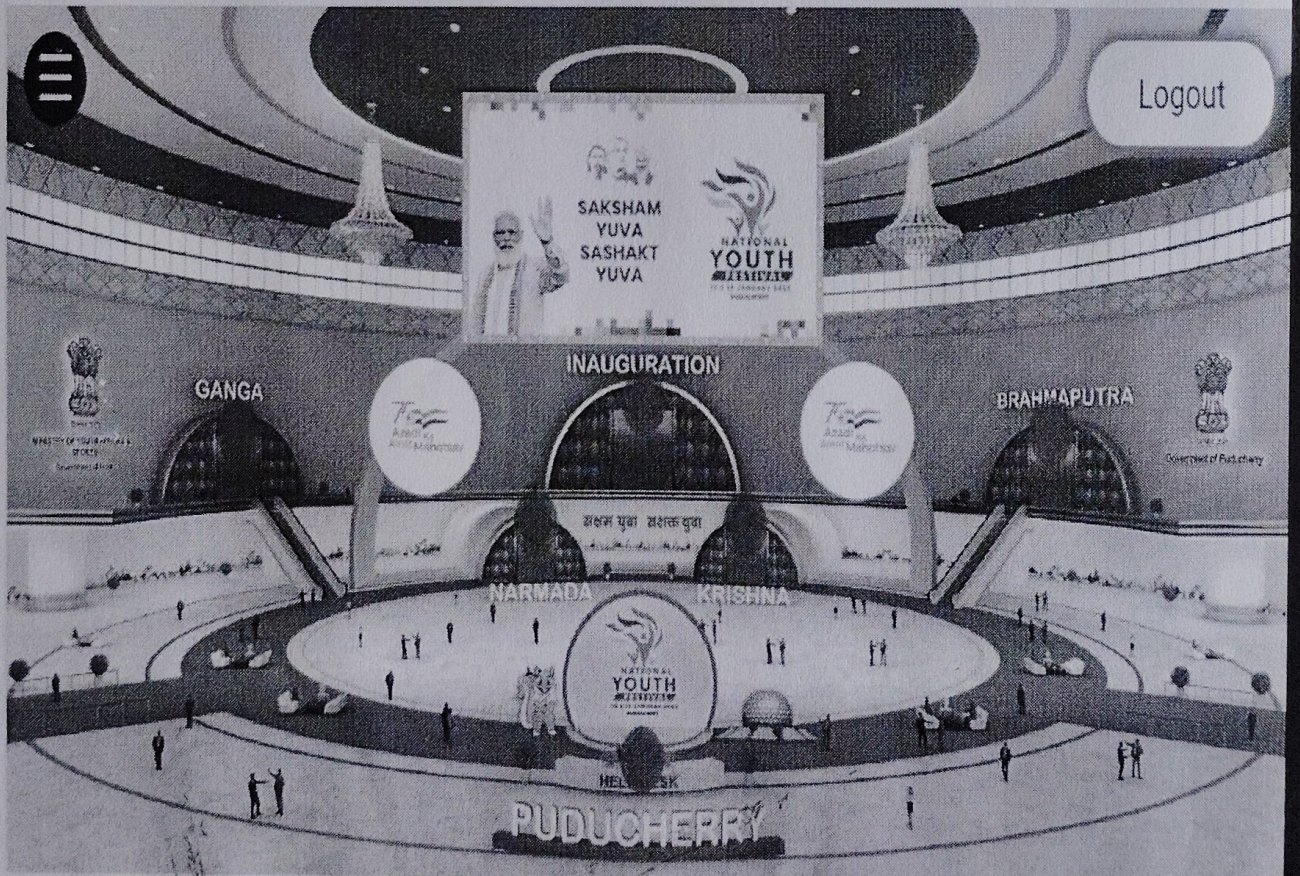

EVENT: Online Competitions

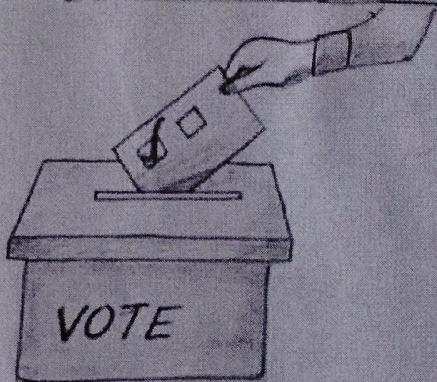
"Making our Voters Empowered,

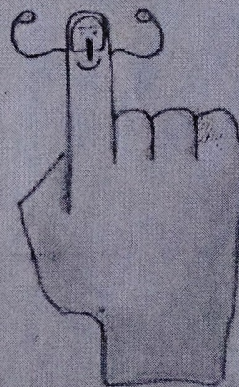
Thus the Government of India has decided to celebrate National Voter's Day on 25<sup>th</sup> of January.

This session clarified that solar energy is cost-effective and a workable solution for the present and future generations.



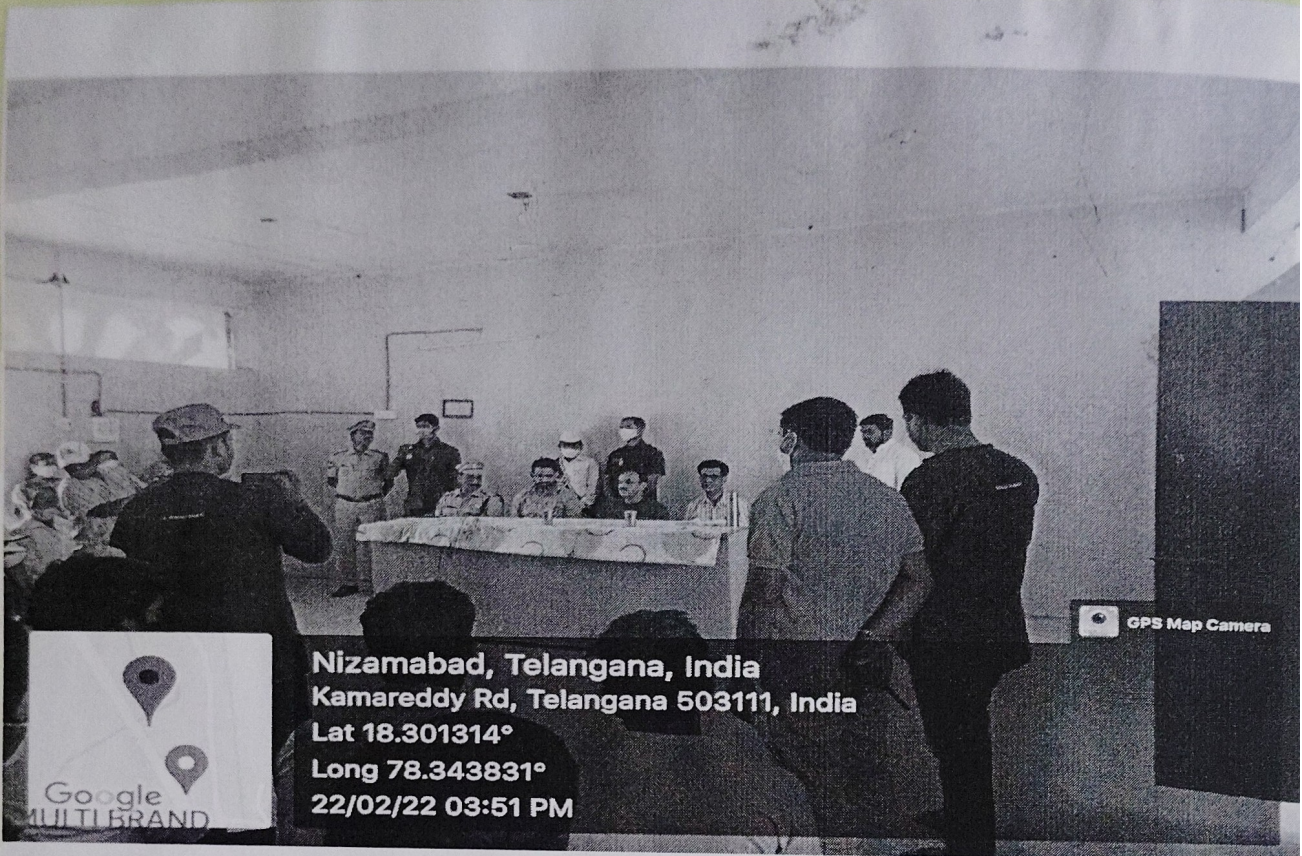

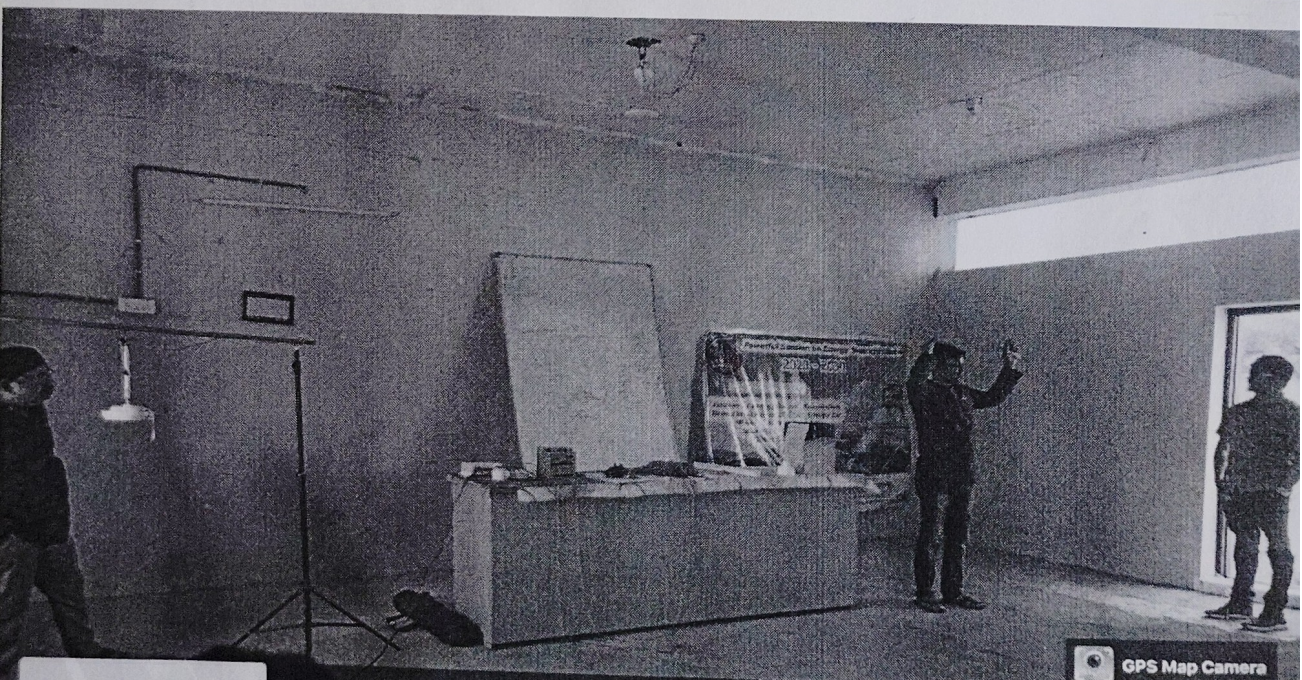

# AWARENESS PROGRAMME ON HIV/AIDS ON

EVENT: .Positive Talk.

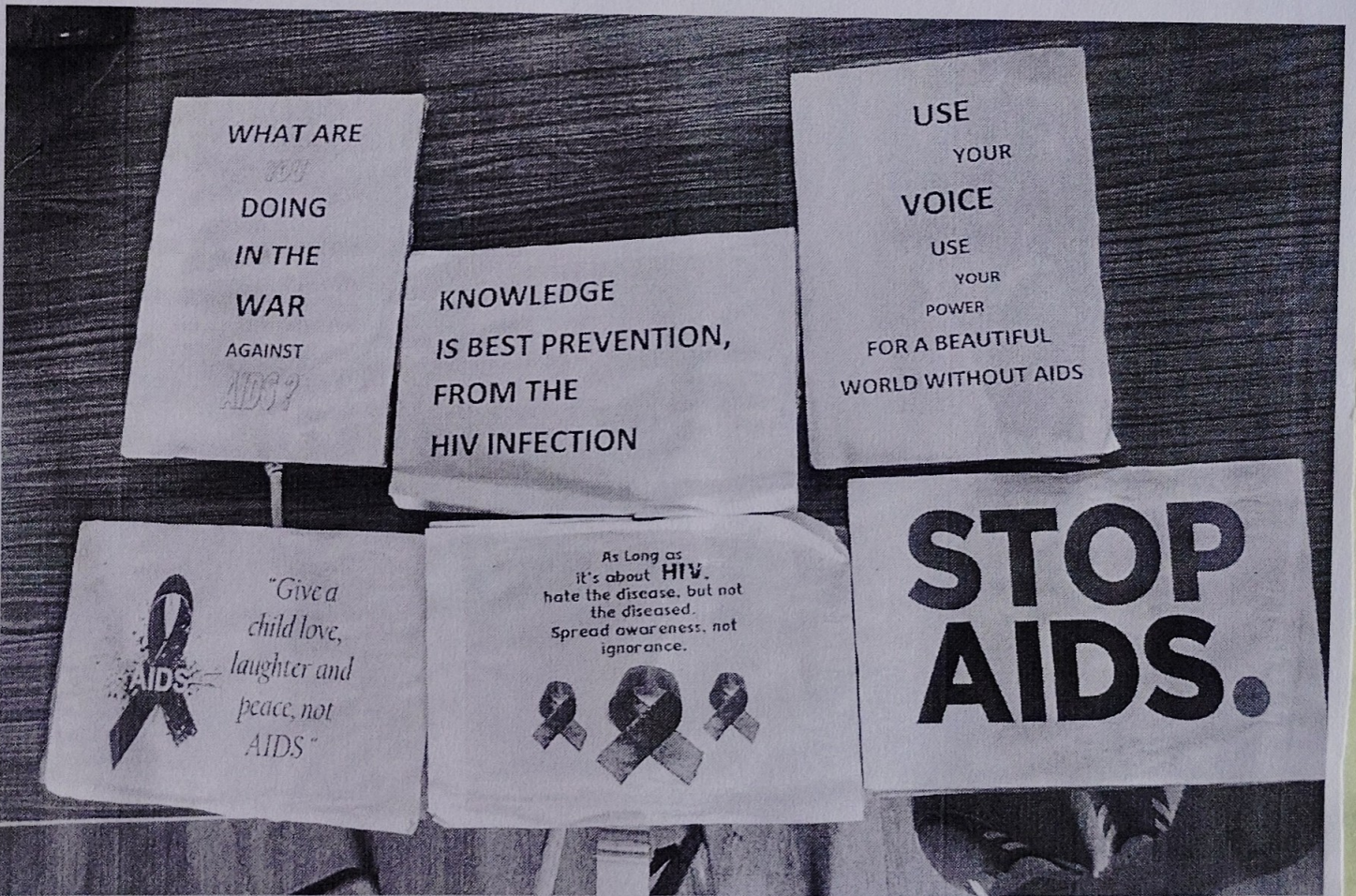
"Prevention is Better than Cure.  
Especially, when something has No Cure"

The quote above signifies the need to create awareness on prevention of AIDS. HIV/AIDS has become a household topic thanks to the awareness that spreads through media. However, a face to face interaction would be more effective.

The NSS unit of TTWRDC (M), Kamareddy in association with Red Ribbon Club (RRC) conducted an awareness programme on HIV/AIDS on 12<sup>th</sup> March 2022 in the Seminar Hall within the college campus.

The main speakers of the event were Mr. Nagaraju and Mr. Sudhakar, who are working as HIV/AIDS control district managers, Kamareddy, along with Ms. Rani, the monitoring coordinator of an NGO, WORD. They enlightened the students about the precautionary measures to be taken to keep away from the disease.





Mr. Nagaraju spoke on the various ways through which one can be infected by HIV/AIDS. He explained the transmission modes and how they can be avoided by taking necessary precautions.

He also gave a brief idea of how an infected person can be taken care of and where the person can be taken for recovery and other aspects.

Another speaker, Mr. Sudhakar elucidated the ABC, of the precautionary measures one has to take.

Here, A is to Abstain  
B is to Be faithful  
and C is Condom

Ms. Rani spoke about their NGO WORD, which builds a communication network among several HIV/AIDS infected people. This helps in creating rapport and awareness on the disease and recovery from it. Moreover, it facilitates a kind of trust building among the patients who are usually segregated from the society. She also encouraged students and staff to not discriminate the infected people.

Mr. Manohar, Faculty of Zoology of our college, TTWRDC (M) Kamareddy, interacted with students on the same topic, giving his expertise on HIV/AIDS. All the faculty of the college and students participated in this awareness programme.
