Event Highlights:

Inauguration Ceremony: The celebration commenced with a formal inauguration, where Manjula Lecturer in Telugu, the Chief Guest Dr. V. Uma Devi Principal delivered an inspiring speech on the life and achievements of Kaloji Narayana Rao. The ceremony included the lighting of the lamp and a floral tribute to Kaloji Narayana Rao portrait. Also Ch. This juxtaposition forms a conversation-like intimate encounter with him capturing perspectives for a better world and the human essence demystifying the legendary personality." including academics and local leaders, shared their insights and encouraged attendees to follow Kaloji Narayana Rao's example of dedication and service.
