## Memorandum of Understanding

Between

Medak Municipality, Medak District

And

Telangana Tribal Welfare Residential Degree College for Women, Medak

Subject: Collaboration for Campus Maintenance and Waste Management

### Background:

Telangana Tribal Welfare Residential Degree College, Medak acknowledges the valuable assistance provided by Municipality in maintaining the cleanliness of the college campus surroundings and managing waste generated within the premises. This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) outlines the terms and conditions of collaboration between the two parties for ensuring effective maintenance and waste management services.

### Terms of Collaboration:

#### 1. Campus Maintenance:

- Municipality, Medak District shall provide workers and equipment for removing bushes, grass, and other vegetation outside of the college campus in a timely manner.
- Assistance from Municipality workers shall be sought for fogging activities during outbreaks like COVID-19 and bleaching the campus surroundings as necessary.

#### 2. Waste Management:

- Municipality workers shall collect both dry and wet waste generated from the college kitchen and hostels regularly and dispose of it responsibly and train college students on waste management.
- In the event of deceased animals such as monkeys and dogs found within or around the campus, Municipality workers shall assist in their removal promptly.

3. Water Supply Assistance:

- During periods of water scarcity due to power cuts or other reasons, Municipality shall collaborate with the college to supply water tankers to ensure uninterrupted water availability for essential needs.

4. Responsibilities of Residential College:

- Provide necessary access and cooperation to Municipality workers for carrying out maintenance and waste management activities within the campus premises.
- Ensure timely communication with Municipality regarding any specific requirements or emergencies related to campus maintenance, waste management, or water supply.
- College must organize awareness programs to students and parents in dry and wet waste management
- College must provide separate dry and wet waste dustbins in and around the campus.
- College will organize cleanliness Drives through outreach and NSS Committees every year.
- College will maintain litter free campus by disposing plastic and e- waste through no disposable Saturday programme.
- College will educate the neighbourhood community in different aspects like dry waste, wet waste management, blocking of drainages in surroundings due to plastic waste, disposing of sanitary pads etc.

5. Responsibilities of Municipality:

- Deploy sufficient manpower and resources to fulfil the obligations outlined in this MoU.
- Coordinate closely with the college authorities to address any issues or concerns promptly and efficiently.


6. Duration:


