MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MOU) Date: 04.09.2021

BETWEEN

OFFICE OF THE DEPUTY SUPERINTENDENT OF POLICE

AND

NSS UNIT 1 OF TELANGANA TRIBAL WELFARE RESIDENTIAL
DEGREE COLLEGE FOR WOMEN, MEDAK

Background:

The Organization and the DSP Office recognize the importance of collaboration in promoting National Service Scheme (NSS) activities around the district. Both parties aim to enhance community engagement, social responsibility, and civic awareness through joint efforts and cooperation.

Purpose:

This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) outlines the terms and conditions of collaboration between the Organization and the DSP Office for the purpose of coordinating and facilitating NSS activities around the district.

Terms of Agreement:

1. Scope of Collaboration:

Both parties agree to collaborate on NSS activities around the district, which may include but is not limited to:

- Providing support for NSS volunteers during events and activities.
- Any other activities aimed at promoting the objectives of NSS in the district.

2. Responsibilities:

- The Organization agrees to coordinate and facilitate NSS activities, including event planning, volunteer recruitment, and resource mobilization.



- The DSP Office agrees to provide support and assistance as needed for the successful implementation of NSS activities, including logistical support, security arrangements, and coordination with local authorities.

- Both parties shall designate focal points for communication and coordination.

3. Confidentiality:

Both parties agree to maintain the confidentiality of any sensitive information shared during the collaboration and to use it solely for the purpose outlined in this MoU.

4. Resource Sharing:

Both parties may share resources, expertise, or facilities as mutually agreed upon to facilitate the collaboration.

5. Duration:

This MoU shall come into effect on the date of signature by both parties and shall remain in force for a period of five years, unless terminated earlier by mutual agreement in writing.


6. Amendments:


Any amendments to this MoU shall be made in writing and signed by authorised representatives of both parties.
