**SUMMARY OF THE EVENT:**

**Objective:**

In an effort to promote sustainable and environment-friendly celebrations, NSS UNIT in collaboration with ECO CLUB organized an **Eco-Friendly Ganesh Idol Making Competition**, encouraging students to embrace creativity while also being conscious of ecological responsibility. The initiative also included the **distribution of these idols to local families**, spreading the message of green festivities.

**About the Competition:**

- Students created **Ganesh idols using eco-friendly materials** such as:
  - Natural clay (shadu mitti)
  - Leaves, turmeric, flowers, and biodegradable decorations
- The focus was on **non-toxic, water-soluble, and non-plastic** idols that do not pollute water bodies after immersion.

- The competition witnessed enthusiastic participation from students across various departments.

- Use of Eco-Friendly Materials
- Cultural Relevance and Symbolism
- Message of Sustainability

**Winners** were awarded prizes, and their idols were displayed in the college exhibition area before distribution.

### **Community Distribution:**

Following the competition:

- The eco-friendly idols were distributed **to families residing around the college premises**, particularly those who may not have the means to purchase idols.
- NSS and Eco Club volunteers personally visited homes and shared a short message about the **importance of eco-conscious celebrations**.
- Each idol came with a **tag/card** explaining its environmental benefits and immersion instructions.
