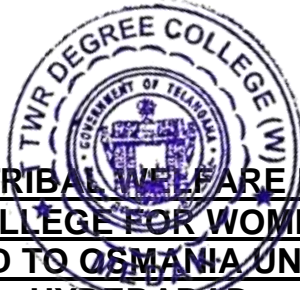

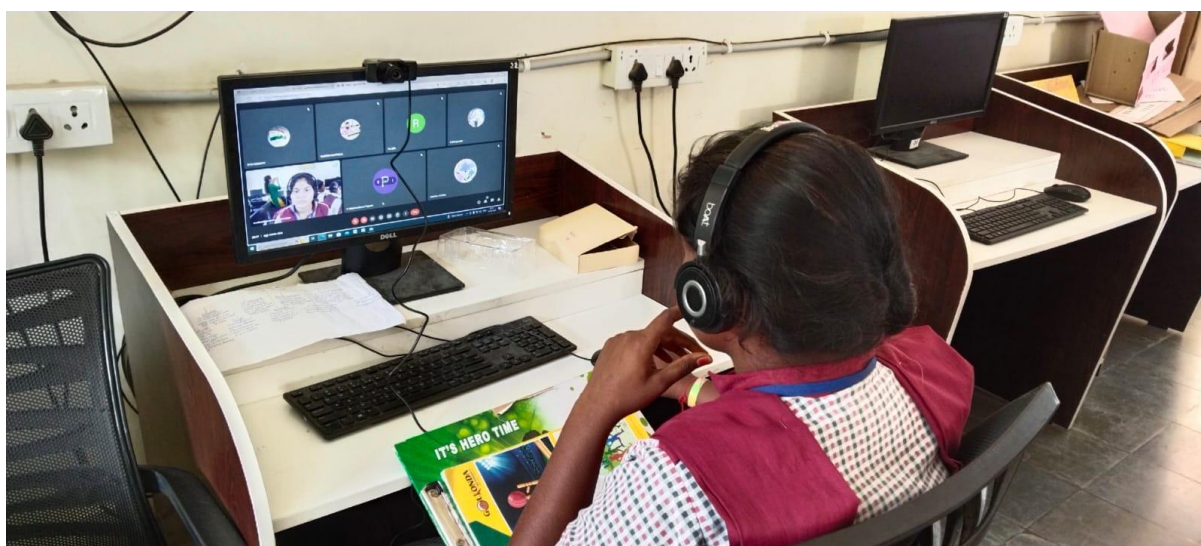

## ACTIVITY - 8

**NAME OF THE EVENT:** EVM and VVPAT DEMONSTRATION

**DATE:** 06.10.2023

**NO OF VOLUNTEERS:** 38      **LOCATION:** COLLECTORATE, MEDAK

### **SUMMARY OF THE EVENT:**

Our volunteers were taken to the Collectorate for demonstration of EVM VVPAT method to students as this year our students got the chance to vote for the first time. Also the vvpata method of voting is new to all the people of the state for this the govt took initiative to give demonstration to all the people whoever visit to the collectorate. In this regard we took our volunteers to the same and made them explain the same to their family members before elections.

#### **1. Setup:**

- EVMs are typically divided into two units: the Control Unit and the Ballot Unit.
- The Control Unit is managed by the polling officer and is used to control the voting process.
- The Ballot Unit is where voters cast their votes.

#### **2. Voting Process:**

- **Voter Identification:** Voters identify themselves to the polling staff, who verify their credentials and mark them as verified.
- **Casting Vote:** The voter presses the button corresponding to their choice on the Ballot Unit.
- **Recording Vote:** When the voter presses a button, the Control Unit records the vote electronically. The vote is stored in the machine's memory.

#### **3. End of Voting:**

- At the end of polling, the Control Unit is used to generate results. It provides the number of votes each candidate has received.
- The data can be transferred to a computer for counting or can be manually tallied from the printed report generated by the EVM.

### **Demonstration Steps:**

#### **1. Explain the Components:**

- Show the Control Unit and Ballot Unit of the EVM.
- Demonstrate the VVPAT machine and explain its role.

#### **2. Simulate Voting:**

- Go through a mock voting process, demonstrating how a vote is cast on the Ballot Unit and recorded by the Control Unit.
  - Show how the VVPAT generates and displays the paper slip.
- 3. Verification Process:**
- Explain how the paper slip can be used to verify the vote recorded electronically.
  - Show how the paper slips are stored in the VVPAT unit and discuss how they are counted if necessary.
- 4. End of Polling:**
- Demonstrate how the results are generated from the EVM and how they can be cross-verified with the VVPAT slips.

national unity, integrity, and security, celebrating India's diversity while reinforcing its unity.

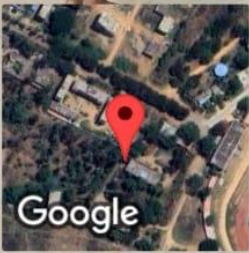

### Objectives:

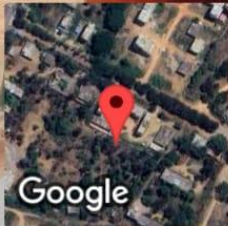
1. To raise awareness about HIV/AIDS and its prevention.

- **Community Support:** The event fostered a sense of community and support, encouraging individuals to be more empathetic and proactive about HIV prevention.

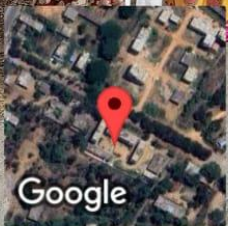

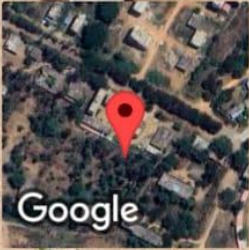
