- ▶ Total NSS candidates is: 80

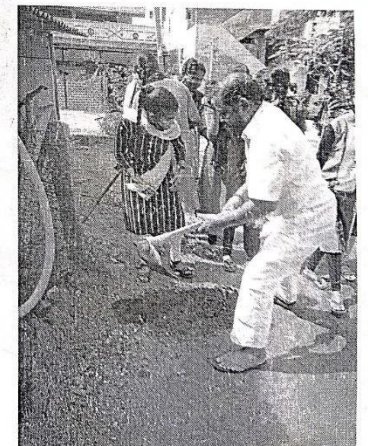

- ▶ And disposed unwanted furniture etc. and won 1st prize and with prize money Rs.20000/-



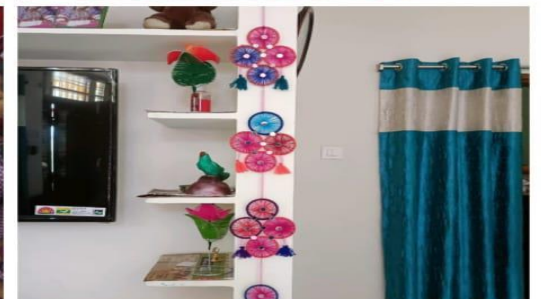
ACTIVITES UNDER NSS
