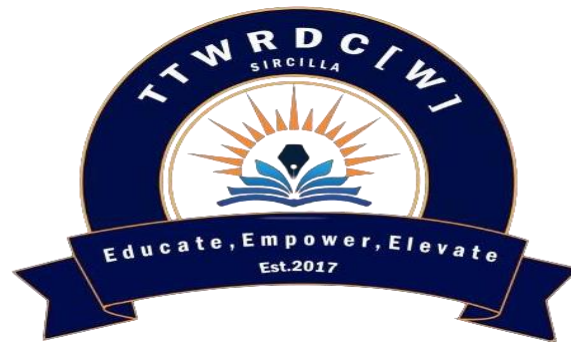

**Title:Village Learning Centres[vlc] by our Students during lockdown**

**Date:15-08-2020**

### Introduction:

Village Learning Centres (VLCs) were organised by the students during the COVID-19 pandemic – lock down, in their respective villages and taught various topics to students residing in their villages. Organising VLCs were very helpful to improve

their academic skills and to tackle the pandemic like situation in future. The VLCs helped to enlighten students other than *Gurukulam*.

We monitored the activities of VLC centres through online mode. We took the status and every day to day report of VLCs.

The COVID-19 pandemic posed unprecedented challenges to education worldwide, disrupting traditional learning environments. However, amidst these challenges, the students of the Tribal Welfare Residential Degree College for Women (TTWRDC(W)) in Rajanna Sircilla district displayed remarkable resilience and innovation by establishing a Village Learning Centre (VLC) during the lockdown period. 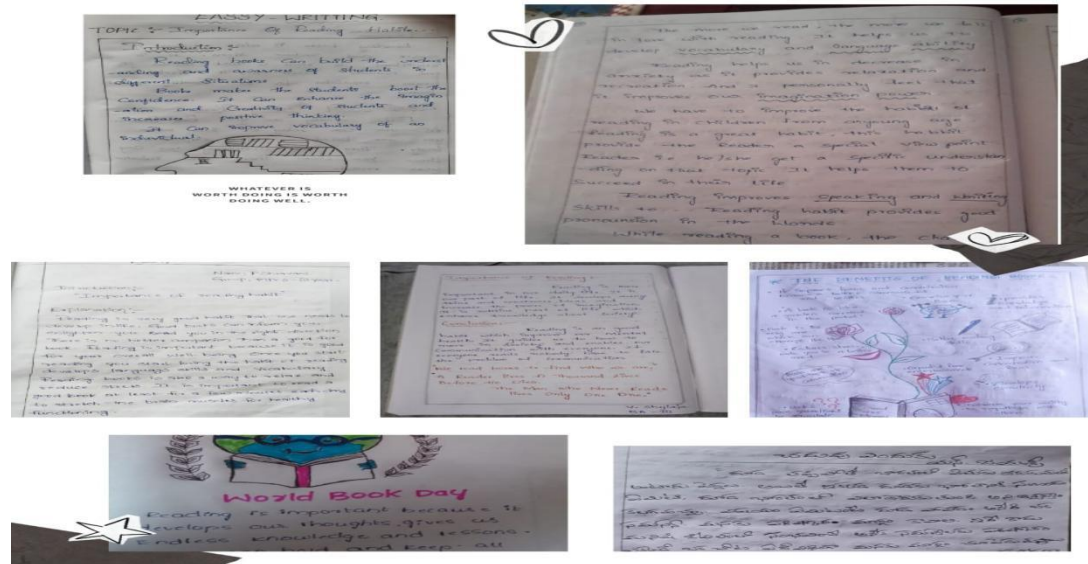
