- He explained about English language sounds. He said 44 sounds are represented by 26 letters in English language. These 44 sounds are further divided into 20 vowel sounds and 24 consonant sounds. These vowel sounds are again divided into 12 pure vowels and 8 diphthongs.
- Consonant sounds start again divided into 2 types voiceless and voiced consonants
- He explained about each sound in detail and how they are pronounced in English language.
- He suggested all the students to learn English language sounds with easy techniques
- Speaker lectured that each sound and symbol with examples.
- he suggested all the students he suggested all the students that English language sounds are very useful to pronounce and to understand English and foreign languages.
- So sound training not only helps an English student to speak with the right pronunciation but also speak with the right stress in a very short time.

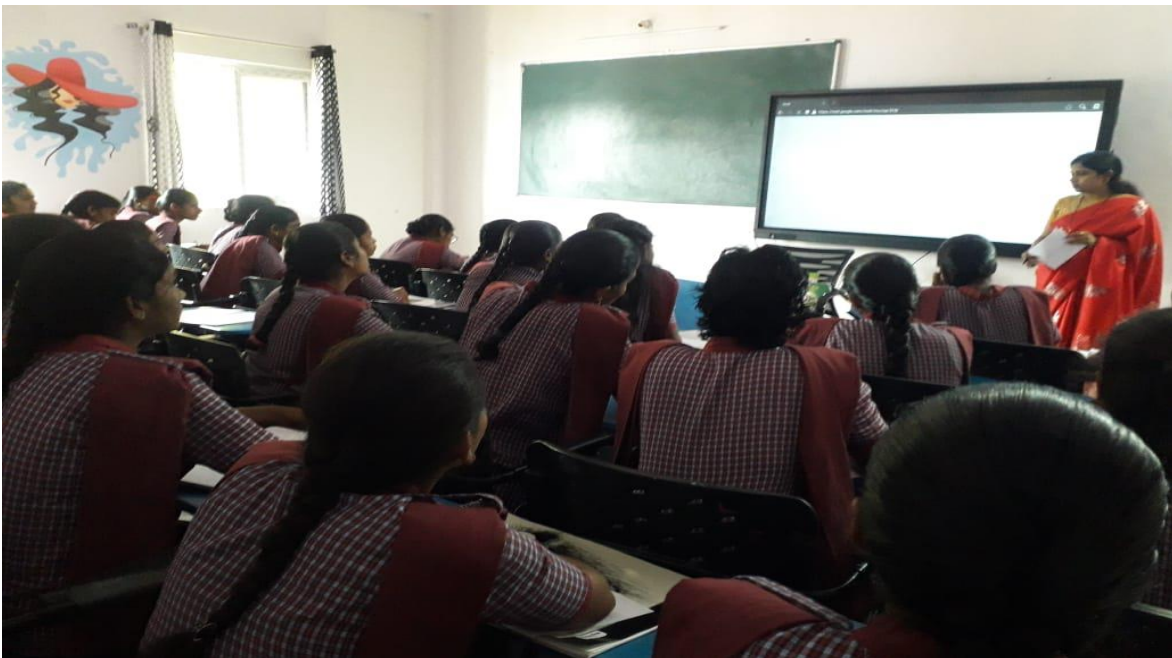

**About the program –**

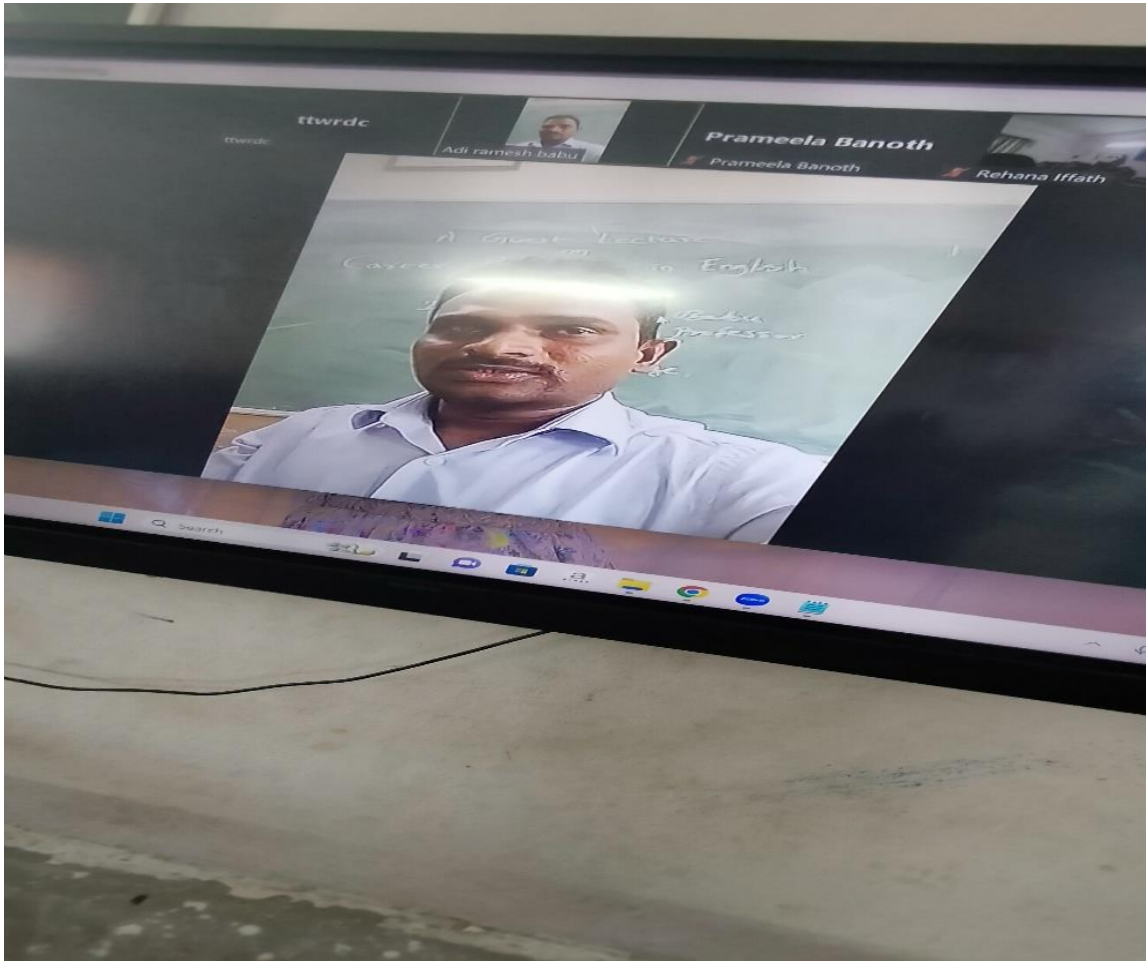
- An online orientation program on EEE's in English was organised by the department of English on 24-03-2023 for all final year students.
