The primary objectives of the workshop were:

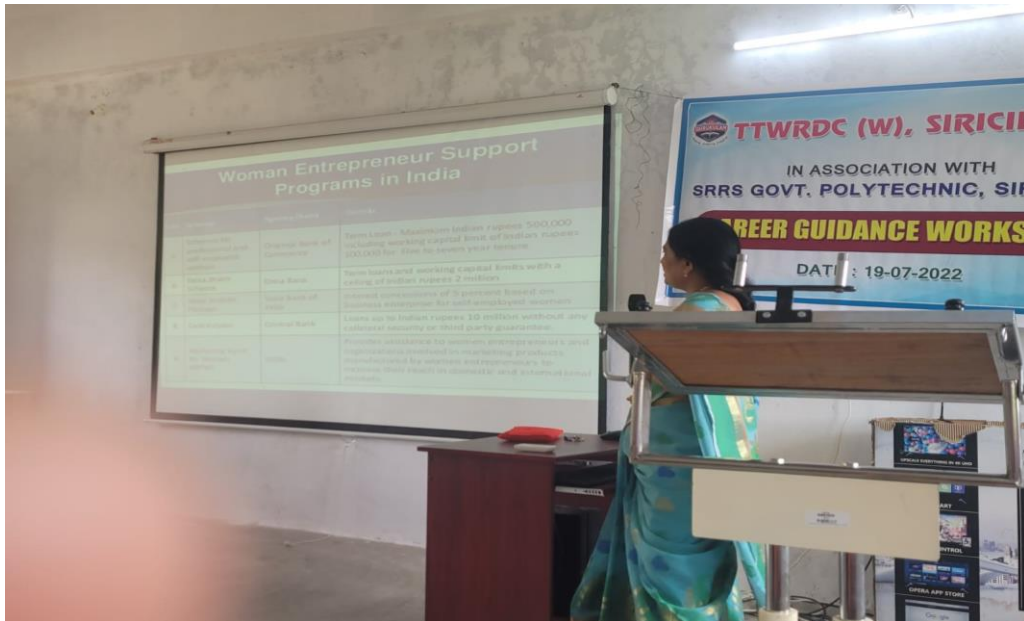

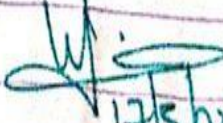
They came from Vijayawada. Mrs. S. Jayalaxmi invented this project and made her own home as a napkin production factory.
